



Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect your personal information when you use our services or interact with us. We are committed to safeguarding your privacy and complying with the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013(POPIA) and other applicable Data Protection Laws.

To help you understand this notice, we include the explanations of the terms of “personal” Information and “process” as used in POPIA.

Personal Information and special personal information are any information relating to an identifiable living or juristic person. Some examples are gender, marital status, religion, postal or biometric or employment history.

Process means any operation or activity, whether automated or not concerning personal information including collection, receipt, recording, organisation, storage, upgrading or modification, retrieval, alteration, consultation, use, dissemination by means of transmission, distribution or making available in merging, linking, as well as blocking, duration, erasure or destruction of information. “Processing” will have a similar meaning

Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of personal information when we

- Contact information (e.g., name, email address, phone number)
- Demographic information (e.g., age, gender, location)
- Financial information (e.g., payment details)
- Log data and device information (e.g., IP address, browser type, operating system)

When you fill in a form on our website.

- Apply for membership.
- Register for events or programs.
- Communicate with us by email, phone, or in person.

How We Use Your Information for the following purposes:

- Providing and improving our services

We will only use your information for the purpose for which it was collected, such as:

- Processing membership applications
- Facilitating events, programs, and networking opportunities
- Sending updates, newsletters, marketing material
- and relevant communication
- Complying with legal and regulatory requirements
- Personalizing your experience

Information Sharing and Disclosure

We may share your personal information with:

- Third-party service providers who assist us in operating our business
- Legal authorities in response to legal requests or investigations
- Affiliates or business partners with whom we collaborate

Data Security

We implement security measures to protect your personal information from unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction. However, no method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

Sharing your information

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information.

We will only share your information:

- With your consent
- Where required by law
- With trusted service providers who help us deliver our services (under strict confidentiality agreements)

- Opt-out of receiving marketing communications
- Exercise your data protection rights as provided by applicable laws
